

LIKA Event Committee Participation Information

All drivers aged 14+ entered at LIKA practice and race events are required to participate in a Committee. Drivers under age 14 must have a parent participate in a Committee for them. All LIKA Members aged 14+ are required to indicate a Committee choice on their LIKA Membership Application. The following information is provided as an aid to making an informed choice of Committees. Training seminars and detailed guides are planned for each Committee in order to provide a better understanding of how to properly participate. Please note that all drivers aged 14+ or a parent of all drivers under age 14 are required to stay until the end of an event to assist with track take-down and to sign out for the day, regardless of their Committee choice. Committee participation is in addition to drivers' Corner Flagging requirements.

Track Setup - Participants are to become familiar with track equipment and proper track setup procedures. On the days they attend an event, Track Committee Participants are expected to arrive early enough to assist with track set-up, typically beginning between 7:30 and 8:00 am. Drivers who are not able to arrive by 8:00 am are encouraged to select another Committee to avoid penalties. Some aspects of track set-up and take-down are physically demanding in requiring track equipment to be lifted, carried, or moved.

Scoring - Participants are to become familiar with LIKA's scoring system components, their setup, operation and procedures, and radio operation and procedures. On the days they attend events, Scoring Committee Participants are to assist with scoring system set-up and take-down. Also, Scoring Committee Participants are to operate the scoring system for qualifying and race heats during certain race groups that do not conflict with their own race group participation.

Scales - Participants are to become familiar with LIKA's electronic scale components, scale operation, the procedures involved in measuring, documenting, and reporting kart weights, and radio operation and procedures. On the days they attend events, Scales Committee Participants are to assist with scale system set-up and take-down. Also, Scales Committee Participants are to operate the scale system for qualifying and race heats during certain race groups that do not conflict with their own race group participation.

Start/Finish - Participants are to become familiar with the procedures involved in flagging at the Start and Finish lines, and radio operation and procedures. The Start/Finish Committee Participants will also become familiar with coordinating their actions with Scoring. On the days they attend events, Start/Finish Committee Participants are to assist with setting up the start and finish line flagging equipment. Also, Start/Finish Committee Participants are to flag at the Finish line for practice and qualifying and at the Start or Finish lines for race heats during certain race groups that do not conflict with their own race group participation.

Pre-Tech and Post-Tech - Pre-Tech and Post-Tech Committee Participants are to become familiar with LIKA, WKA, Rotax, and TaG USA rules, as appropriate, and the procedures involved in performing Pre- or Post- race tech inspection. On the days they attend events, Pre-Tech Committee Participants are to inspect karts for safety and class compliance before and during the first practice session, and Post-Tech Committee participants are to inspect karts for technical legality, under the direction of the Chief of Post-Race Technical Inspection, during and after the last race session.
